



**2020 ELECTION OF TRUSTEE – DISTRICT 2 TRUSTEE
OKLAHOMA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT FUND (“OkMRF”)**

Trustee nominations were opened in May for District 2 for a five year term beginning October 1, 2020. Robert Park, City of Sallisaw, currently holds the position. Notices to District 2 Members were mailed the first week of May and nominations were held open until June 30, 2020. As a Member of District 2, you had the right to nominate one person to fill the expiring office in this district. Such nominations were made by Resolution and filed with the OkMRF office by June 30, 2020. We received two (2) nominations. OkMRF prepared a ballot listing the names with the background and experience of both nominees. We mailed a certified ballot to you on or by July 20, 2020. The governing body of each employer in District 2 was entitled to cast by resolution one vote. The ballot was furnished and had to be returned to OkMRF between July 20th and August 30, 2020. OkMRF received eight (8) votes split between the incumbent, Bob Park and the challenger, Lou Ann Moore.

On August 31, 2020, OkMRF declared the election a tie. Therefore, our trust indenture, requires we send a second certified mailing to you with a tie breaking ballot.

The governing body of each employer in District 2 is entitled to cast a new vote by resolution to break the tie. **Any prior votes will not count.**

The ballot will be mailed on September 1, 2020, and must be returned to OkMRF between September 10th and **October 20, 2020**. We appreciate your cooperation and patience during the 2020 District 2 Trustee election process!
